4.5. A one-time licensing fee is charged in the amount of one subsistence minimum based on the subsistence minimum for able-bodied persons effective as of the date of the NEURC's decision to issue the license.

The licensee shall pay the licensing fee within ten business days of making a record on the decision to issue the license in the license register.

The document confirming the payment of the licensing fee shall be a copy of the receipt issued by the bank, a copy of the payment order bearing the bank's marking, a payment terminal receipt, or a receipt (check) from the postal service.
