Having regard to the provisions of Article 3 of Regulation (EU) 2019/943 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 June 2019 on the internal market in electricity, as well as a letter from the European Commission ENER/A5/CB/hr (2021) s-533549 dated 26 January 2021, registered with the National Energy Regulatory Authority under no. 8.881 of 27 January 2021,

Under the provisions of Art. 5 par. (1) letter c) and Art. 9 par. (1) letter h) of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 33/2007on the organisation and functioning of the National Energy Regulatory Authority, approved with amendments and additions by Law no. 160/2012, with subsequent amendments and additions,

the President of the National Energy Regulatory Authority shall issue the following order:

Art. I

Order of the President of the National Energy Regulatory Authority no. 65/2020 amending and supplementing some orders of the President of the National Energy Regulatory Authority, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, no. 274 of 1 April 2020, is amended as follows:

Article VII shall be amended and shall read as follows:

"- Art. VII

- (1)In application of Article 3(o) of Regulation (EU) 2019/943 of Parliament The European and Council of 5 June 2019 on the internal market in electricity (recast), a long-term supply contract, means a supply contract with a delivery duration equal to or greater than one month.
- 2. Supply contracts referred to in paragraph 1 shall be concluded in compliance with competition law and shall be reported in accordance with Article 8(1) of Regulation (EU) 2011/1.227 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 October 2011 on the integrity and transparency of the wholesale energy market.';

Art. II

The economic operators in the electricity sector, the National Transport Company "Transelectrica" – S.A. and the Company Operator of the Electric Energy and Natural Gas Market "OPCOM" – S.A. comply with the provisions of this order.

Art. III

The specialised directorates of the National Energy Regulatory Authority shall follow the observance of the provisions of this Order.

Art. IV

This order shall be published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, and shall enter into force on the day of its publication.
